CORE COURSES 2023-2024

As you are aware, the Commission’s mandatory course, Core A, “3-D Rules: Disclose, Disclose, Disclose!”, is currently being offered. Also included in Core A are the 2023 real estate-related legislative updates. For the most up-to-date information on this new legislation, it is recommended licensees complete Core A in the first year of the biennium (now!), and Core B in the second year of the biennium.

Core B 2023-2024 will focus on the topic of the Regulated Industries Complaints Office (RICO), the applicable laws and rules that govern real estate brokers and salespersons, RICO’s divisions and their functions, the complaints process, the Real Estate Recovery Fund, case scenarios, and applicable legislative updates. Core B will be developed in 2024.

Reminder – both Core A and Core B courses must be completed in order to receive continuing education core course credit. If only one core course is completed, the licensee will not receive any core course credit.

Please submit core course and instructor evaluation forms to the Real Estate Branch within 10 days of course completion.

TRAIN-THE-TRAINER – CORE A

Train-the-Trainer was hosted by the Honolulu Board of REALTORS® (HBR) on June 26, 2023. The training was led by course author, Everett Kaneshige, and there were 43 instructors/participants in virtual attendance.

Instructors who missed this session and wish to teach Core A, “3-D Rules: Disclose, Disclose, Disclose!”, may email the Real Estate Branch at roster@dcca.hawaii.gov, to request the YouTube link so they may complete this training session. As you are aware, instructors must complete the corresponding training session prior to teaching this or any core course.

PSI REGISTRATION UPDATE

Registering for Licensing Exams – Changes Are On The Way

Aloha,

We recently sent out an email informing Prelicense Schools that the School Completion Certificates will now include a Candidate ID number. So, what is this Candidate ID number and what is its significance? The Candidate ID number is a Ho`ala-generated, 9-digit identification number that will be randomly assigned and unique to each applicant.

The addition of the Candidate ID is Step 1 of our plan to change the way a candidate registers for the real estate examination. In the near future, candidates will no longer initiate the registration process. Instead, once a prelicense student/candidate becomes eligible to sit for the exam, they will receive an email directly from PSI stating that they may now register for a specific exam (i.e. Salesperson State and National, Salesperson Equivalency, Broker State and National, or Broker Equivalency).

What does this mean for prelicense schools? We will need your help to ensure a smooth transition to this new process. This means updating your instructions to include this new process of waiting for an email from PSI. Additionally, please reiterate to the students that when they create a MyPVL account, their name must match their government-issued ID. Lastly and most important, we need schools to remember to “Submit the Attendee” in our Education Portal once the student completes the course (see image below):

The list of eligible candidates is only generated once you “Submit Attendee”. If you miss this step and do not submit the attendee, PSI will not receive notification to send an eligibility email to the student.

We are hoping to have the new process up and running by November 2023. In the meantime, continue to monitor your email as we will be sending information regarding the exact date of release, updated instructions to provide to students, and sample emails that students will be receiving from PSI.

*For Carmel Streater courses, completion of only one training course is necessary to fulfill the IDW requirement. Please note that a course shall only be taken once; a repeated course will not be recognized.

As you know, instructors are required to attend an REC-approved IDW and submit proof of completion with their applications for instructor certifications and recertifications. We encourage instructors to visit the link above for more information and to take your IDW course well-ahead of the renewal period.



UPDATES – EDUCATION SYSTEM

Issues that CE Providers and Prelicense Schools have reported to the Real Estate Branch have been relayed to the developer. If you are aware of any “glitches” in the Education System, please report it to the Real Estate Branch at 808-586-2643, or via email roster@dcca.hawaii.gov.

Here is a list of current issues that have been reported:

- Middle names are not being included on the Prelicense School Completion Certificate. Unfortunately, sometime in the middle of July, we received multiple reports that students added their middle name when they initially registered for a MyPVL account; however, their middle name is not appearing on their certificate. Please either email us the student’s full name and email address, and we can adjust it on our end or have the student call us directly at (808)586-2643. Please have them ask to speak to either Charisa or Nohe.

- When you are ready to finalize the course and use the button “Mark Class as Complete and Submit Roster,” nothing happens, and the course remains “Open”. Please note that the attendees are still being submitted but the course itself is not changing statuses.
- The “To be active in the xx-xx biennium” table that is visible in the CE Status menu and visible to licensees via their MyPVL account has been unreliable. Sometimes the biennium is incorrect and/or the credit hours are not properly updated. Currently, the system does not account for licensees who have been delinquent for more than one year (30-hour requirement vs. 20-hour requirement). If a licensee has any questions on the restoration requirements for their license, please have them call our office.
- Periodically, the CE History Table does not sort by biennium. This issue was previously fixed, but we have received reports that it still does not sort properly.

*Note the issues noted above does not cover every complaint or request for improvement submitted to our office, these are just a few of the most pressing.

We want to take this time to thank everyone for their patience. We understand that these “glitches” that occur with our system are inconvenient to all parties affected. We are working diligently to produce both short-term and long-term fixes to many of these common issues. Our ultimate goal is to create a better system for our users. Unfortunately, when we transitioned to a new online platform, we mimicked what was previously in place to ensure a quick transition; however, the old system doesn’t necessarily work with our new system. We hope that we can create better ways of uploading courses, transmitting prelicense certificates, and meeting your needs as CE Providers and Prelicense Schools. IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

PRELICENSE SCHOOLS

Questionable Background Issues:

Reminder to make all students aware of the “Request for Preliminary Decision Application”. This application should be submitted ONLY for those with a questionable background issue(s). Questionable background issues include, but are not limited to, criminal convictions (felony, misdemeanor, or court martial), or any civil/administrative/government action, including DUIs, drug/alcohol issues, abuse situations, tax liens, unpaid tax obligations, judgments, unpaid judgments, disciplinary action (for another licensing area or from another state or country), applicants currently serving parole or probation, violations of administrative laws/court orders/government sanctions, etc.

Avoid Education System errors:

You may only offer a course that has been registered/re-registered with the Commission. Be sure your course has been registered/re-registered for this biennium prior to offering.

Upon completion of a course, be certain you are adding the attendee information to the correct course and please double-check that the month and year of completion are correct. There have been too many instances when the licensing examination and/or the application for licensure have been questioned and nearly rejected due to incorrect dates being entered.

School Completion Certificates:

As many of you have transitioned to electronic communication and are now providing School Completion Certificates via email, please be sure your students are aware they will be receiving their School Completion Certificates from you electronically.

MyPVL Account:

Students should only “register” once for a MyPVL account and should use the same MyPVL account from prelicense to licensure. This will avoid duplicate accounts, emails, passwords, etc. Students are encouraged to use their personal email, not an email affiliated with an employer. This will avoid being locked out of their MyPVL account should they leave that employer and no longer have access to that email.

Highlight the importance of MyPVL accounts and its functions. Licensees will need to visit their account time and again to renew their licenses every even-numbered year (**whether on an active or inactive status**). Their MyPVL account provides access to their CE history, the ability to print pocket cards, check their license status, and update personal information, etc.

This information should be disseminated to all students when they take prelicensing courses:

1. Students shall register for the prelicensing course using their legal name as stated on their government-issued ID. This will avoid the incorrect name from being printed on their school completion certificate and will enable the student to schedule their exam with PSI without incident/rejection.
2. Prelicense instructors should clearly emphasize that broker candidates must apply for and receive a broker experience certificate (BE) from the REB prior to sitting for the broker licensing exam with PSI. Without an **approved** BE, candidate exams will not be honored.
3. Prelicense instructors should clearly emphasize to broker candidates the importance of the correct dates of employment and importance that the correct number of weeks of full time experience are entered on their Experience Certification Statement(s) (ECS) that accompany their application for broker experience (BE). Incorrect entries on the ECS will result in rejection and/or delays.

CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDERS

Avoid Education System errors:

You may only offer courses that have been certified/re-certified with the Commission. Be sure the course has been certified/re-certified for the current biennium prior to offering.

Upon completion of a continuing education course, be certain you are adding the attendee information to the correct course ID number.

When entering course completion information, please double-check that the correct course dates are entered AND the correct biennium is credited, especially for “make-up” credits.

MyPVL Account:

Highlight the importance of MyPVL accounts and its functions. Licensees will need to visit their account time and again to renew their licenses every even-numbered year (**whether on an active or inactive status**). Their MyPVL account provides access to their CE history, the ability to print pocket cards, check their license status, and update personal information, etc.

This information should be disseminated to all licensees when they take CE courses:

1. Licensees should confirm their information, specifically their real estate license number, is correct when registering for a CE course(s). This will ensure that the proper courses and credit hours are reported to the licensee’s education portal.
2. A CE Provider has 10 days to post a course completion. Licensees should be made aware of that timeline.
3. Licensees may access their CE information via their MyPVL account at <https://mypvl.dcca.hawaii.gov/>. Once logged into their MyPVL account, click on their license number. Next, click on the tab "RECE" (Real Estate Continuing Education). Here licensees will be able to view their history of courses completed and reported to the Commission.

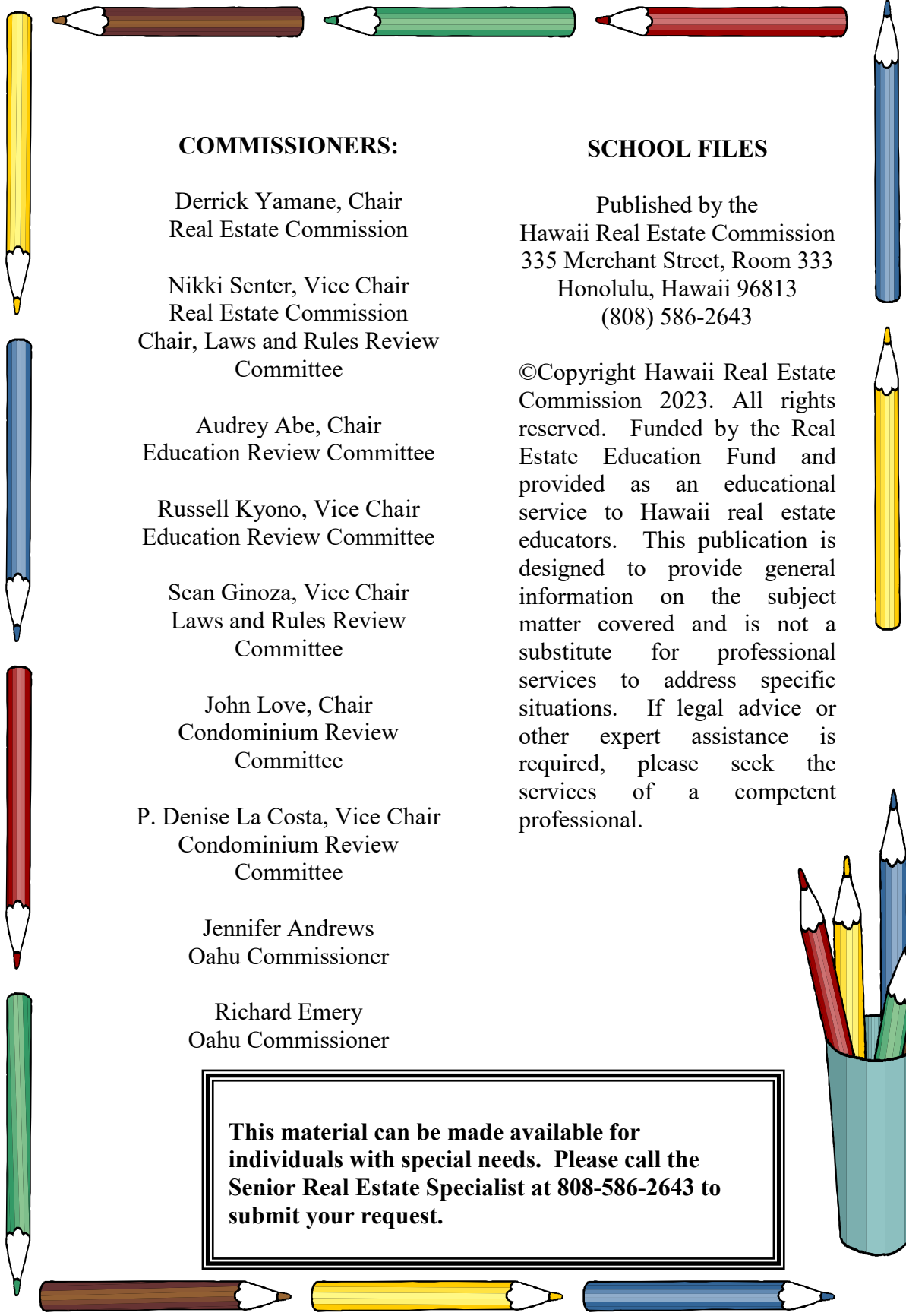
