A brief video regarding the virtual board meeting, including meeting procedures and helpful information regarding how members of the public can participate and interact

with the board during the meeting, was played.

Call to Order:

The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m., at which time quorum was established by roll call.

This meeting had a physical location and a virtual location. Chair Yamane, Supervising Officer Fujitani, Executive Officer Ino, and public member, Hal Wilkerson were in attendance in-person at the physical location. All other Commissioners were in attendance virtually and confirmed that they were present and alone.

Chair's Report:

The Commission may move into executive session to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for licensure in accordance with section 92-5(a)(1), HRS, and/or to consult with the Commission's attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Commission's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities in accordance with section 92-5(a)(4), HRS.

Commissioner Senter was excused from the meeting. Prior notification of her non-attendance was received.

Chair Yamane asked for continued thoughts and prayers to those affected by the Maui wildfires.

Executive Officer's Report:

The Commission shall afford all interested persons an opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, in writing, on any agenda item and shall provide all interested parties an opportunity to present oral testimony on an agenda item subject to the conditions set forth in section 16-99-83, HAR. The Commission may remove any person or persons, who willfully disrupt a meeting to prevent and compromise the conduct of the meeting in accordance with section 92-3, HRS. Each speaker will be limited to a five-minute time period pursuant with section 16-99-83(a)(5), HAR.

Executive Officer Ino was pleased to announce the new Real Estate Recovery Fund (RERF) Clerk, Joyce Lee. He also congratulated Chair Yamane and Real Estate Specialist Jackson for completing ARELLO's Commissioner College.

Minutes of Previous Meeting

Upon a motion by Commissioner Emery, seconded by Commissioner Kyono, it was voted on an unanimously carried to accept the minutes of the August 25, 2023, meeting.

Licensing – Ratification:

Upon a motion by Commissioner Andrews, seconded by Commissioner La Costa, it was voted on and unanimously carried to ratify the September 22, 2023, Approved Applications List.

Laws and Rules Review Committee

Program of Work FY 2023-2024 Commissioners' Education Program Regulated Industries Complaints Office

Chair Yamane welcomed the representatives from the Regulated Industries Complaint Office (RICO.) Present were Esther Brown, Complaints and Enforcement Officer; Debora Sanehira, Supervising Investigator for the Consumer Resource Center; Sean Kinilau, Investigations Manager and Paul Galindo, Acting Supervising Attorney.

Esther Brown thanked the Commission for their service and providing RICO the opportunity to share the functions of their office. She stated RICO is the enforcement agency for the professional and vocational licensing areas within DCCA and the Commission is the final decision maker when it comes to disciplining licensees.

RICO has four (4) major sections – 1) consumer resources center, 2) field investigation, 3) legal section and 4) admin section consisting of the CEO and administrative/support staff. RICO is an independent agency and not an extension of any board or program.

Ms. Brown advised that RICO has several enforcement tools; the chief enforcement tool being education. The RICO website has a vast amount of information for both licensees and the public. The other enforcement tools include complaints processing and official enforcement action.

Debora Sanehira thanked the Commission for their time. She explained that she is with the intake section otherwise known as the Consumer Resource Center. They are the first contact consumers may have with their division. They handle the intake for RICO via phone, written mail and through RICO's web portal. The web portal is a useful tool for consumers to file complaints. Ms. Sanehira gave a brief synopsis of their process when a complaint is filed.

Sean Kinilau stated he is RICO's Field Investigations Manager. The field investigations section handles a wide range of complaints. Mr. Kinilau provided a brief explanation of their process once the complaints are forwarded from the Consumer Resource Center. Mr. Kinilau advised they want licensees to be in compliance and prefer to educate licensees first before forwarding the information to the legal section of RICO.

Paul Galindo stated he has been with RICO since December 2020 and has been the Acting Supervising Attorney since June 2023. He has implemented a three-step process when a complaint has been forwarded to the legal section. Each case is reviewed by three different attorneys. The first step is determining if there is a legal basis to pursue the case, this includes what evidence will be allowed and if witnesses will testify or appear. The second step is an assessment of the initial review for accuracy and finally the Supervising Attorney will review the case and materials.

Commissioner Emery asked if there was any data regarding the number of cases prosecuted/dismissed for associations not providing owners with condo documents in the required time frame. Ms. Brown advised RICO does not compile data in the way Commissioner Emery is asking. Data is gathered by the name of the

respondent, not by the subject matter. The system RICO uses is not set up to track data in that manner. RICO may be able to locate the number of condo doc request complaints, but not a breakdown of the outcome. If a records request is submitted, RICO staff would need to do a manual search.

Commissioner La Costa stated some of the fines noted on the settlement agreements seem low for the violation, she asked how fines are determined. Mr. Galindo advised fines are determined on a case-by-case basis. RICO may have access to other mitigating factors not noted on the settlement agreement but may be present in a hearing. There are also laws that limit the fine amount to \$5,000.00. Commissioner Andrews asked if it was possible to request additional information regarding the settlement agreements and asked why there was a big discrepancy in fines. Ms. Brown advised that communication between RICO and boards/programs are very formal. If the case has proceeded to a hearing, the Hearing Officer includes a detailed summary in their Hearing Officer's Recommended Order. Ms. Brown also advised that the settlement agreements presented to the boards/programs are the best information/outcome RICO could get and that the boards/programs can trust RICO to negotiate an appropriate outcome. It is also the boards/programs prerogative to defer or deny a settlement agreement if they do not agree with it.

Chapter 99, HAR - Status Update

The Commission requested an update from Deputy Attorney General Wong on the status of Chapter 99, Hawaii Administrative Rules. DAG Wong advised she is about 75% through her review of the packet and that she will provide the rules back to staff prior to the next REC meeting

Education Review Committee

Administrative Issues – Continuing Education Providers and Courses Ratification List

Upon a motion by Commissioner Ginoza, seconded by Commissioner Abe, it was voted on and unanimously carried to ratify the September 22, 2023, Continuing Education Providers and Courses Ratification List.

Course – "Real Estate in Estate Planning"; Author/Owner – Scott Alan Bly; Provider – Scott Alan Bly School of Real Estate LLC; Course Categories – Real Estate Law; Clock Hours – 3

Upon a motion by Commissioner Abe, seconded by Commissioner Kyono, it was voted on and unanimously carried to approve "Real Estate in Estate Planning" as a 3-credit hour continuing education course, under the course category Real Estate Law.

Administration of Examinations

Licensing Examination Statistics 8/1/23-8/31/23

PSI submitted the monthly licensing examination statistics as requested.

School Pass/Fail Rates - 8/1/23-8/31/23

The school pass/fail rate statistics for 8/1/23-8/31/23 were distributed to Commissioners for their information. Commissioner La Costa questioned why the pass rates were so low. Specialist Endo advised that the test is developed for the minimally competent candidate. The prelicense schools follow the Commission approved curriculum. PSI has advised in the past that the pass rates were comparable to other state exams.

School Summary by Test Category -- 8/1/23-8/31/23

PSI submitted the monthly school summary by test category statistics as requested.

Exam Monitoring

Kauai site report

A copy of the evaluation report on the monitoring of the Kauai Test Center was distributed to the Commissioners for their information.

Honolulu site report

A copy of the evaluation report of the monitoring of the Honolulu Test Center was distributed to the Commissioners for their information.

Test Development – 2023 updated National Exam

Real Estate Specialist Endo advised PSI completed a new validation study and has updated the National portion of the Broker and Salesperson exams. PSI works hand in hand with ARELLO to ensure testing for the national section is certified since many of the states have reciprocity or equivalency opportunities for real estate agents.

Annual Report, Quarterly Bulletin, and School Files

The July 2023 School Files and August 2023 REC Bulletin were distributed.

Licensing – Applications:

The Chair informed the Commissioners that the information provided to the Commissioners is related only to the issue that is before the Commission for consideration. The other materials submitted are available for the Commissioners review should they desire to review it. If the applicants have an issue, which is personal in nature, they have the right to request that their application be considered in executive session.

The Chair asked the applicants who were present, if they wished to have their applications considered in open/public session or closed, private executive session.
