#### **Condominium Documents – Reminder**

Owners are entitled to a sizable number of documents pursuant to §§514B-152 through 514B-154.5, HRS. Owners who are having trouble obtaining documents from their association or managing company should contact the <u>Regulated Industries Complaints Office</u> for assistance in obtaining documents.

Owners should be aware that any amendments to the declaration or bylaws must be recorded in either Land Court or the <u>Bureau of Conveyances</u> ("BOC") to be enforceable. For both methods, the BOC will ultimately be the final recording agency for the State. Owners may order documents recorded with the BOC through its website.
