(i) Physician (Permanent):

a. Linda Kaufman Derbes, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Takanishi, seconded by Vice-Chair Halford, and carried by the majority, with the exception of Dr. Dao who recused himself from the discussion and vote on this matter, to deny Dr. Derbes's application for licensure.

The Board based its decision on the following citations of the HRS and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR"), which find factual support in the records and files of Dr. Derbes's application:

HRS §453-8 provides that:

(a) In addition to any other actions authorized by law, any license to practice medicine and surgery may be revoked, limited, or suspended by the board at any time in a proceeding before the board, or may be denied, for any cause authorized by law, including but not limited to the following:

* * *

- (7) Professional misconduct, hazardous negligence causing bodily injury to another, or manifest incapacity in the practice of medicine or surgery;
- (9) Conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession as adopted by the Hawaii Medical Association, the American Medical Association, the Hawaii Association of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons, or the American Osteopathic Association;
- (11) Revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another state or federal agency of a license, certificate, or medical privilege;
- (15) Submitting to or filing with the board any notice, statement, or other document required under this chapter, which is false or untrue or contains any material misstatement or omission of fact.

HRS section 436B-19 provides that:

In addition to any other acts or conditions provided by law, the licensing authority may refuse to renew, reinstate or restore, or may deny, revoke, suspend, or condition in any manner, any license for any one or more of the following acts or conditions on the part of the licensee or the applicant thereof:

- (12) Failure to comply, observe, or adhere to any law in a manner such that the licensing authority deems the applicant or holder to be an unfit or improper person to hold a license.

HAR section 16-85-107 provides that:

- (a) An application for issuance of a license or certificate shall be denied when an application is insufficient or incomplete or when an applicant has failed to provide satisfactory proof that the applicant meets the requirements under chapters 453 or 463E, HRS, or this chapter. In addition, the board may deny issuance of a license or certificate:

* * *

- (1) When the applicant has committed any of the acts for which a license or certificate may be suspended

or revoked under sections 453-8 or 463E-6, HRS, or section 16-85-112;

- (2) If the applicant fails to demonstrate that the applicant possesses a good reputation for honesty, truthfulness, fairness, and financial integrity; and
- (3) If the applicant has had disciplinary action taken by any jurisdiction, including any federal or state regulatory body.

The Board considers Dr. Derbes's conduct to be extremely concerning and contrary to the recognized standards of ethics as adopted by the American Medical Association ("AMA"). Specifically, the Board believes that she failed to uphold the following AMA Principles of Medical Ethics:

- II. A physician shall uphold the standards of professionalism, be honest in all professional interactions, and strive to report physicians deficient in character or competence, or engaging in fraud or deception, to appropriate entities.
- III. A physician shall respect the law and also recognize a responsibility to seek changes in those requirements which are contrary to the best interests of the patient.

b. Valerie Janet Connie Willis, D.O.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Jaffe, seconded by Dr. Holt, and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Willis's application for licensure pending a comprehensive assessment and evaluation by a post-licensure assessment program.

The Board cites the following statutory and administrative rule provisions which authorize it to require that Dr. Willis undergo a comprehensive evaluation and assessment:

HRS section 453-4 states in relevant part that:

- (b) Before any applicant shall be eligible for licensure, the applicant shall furnish proof satisfactory to the board that:
 - (1) The applicant is of demonstrated competence and professional knowledge.

HRS section 453-8 provides that:

(b) If disciplinary action related to the practice of medicine has been taken against the applicant by another state or federal agency, or if the applicant reveals a physical or mental condition that would constitute a violation under this section, then the board may impose one or more of the following requirements as a condition for licensure:

* * *

(1) Physical and mental evaluation of the applicant by a licensed physician or osteopathic physician approved by the board.

HRS section 436B-10(a)(9) also states in relevant part that:

(a) Application for a license shall be made on an application form to be furnished by the licensing authority. An applicant shall provide the following information on the application form:

* * *

(9) Any other information the licensing authority may require to investigate the applicant's qualifications for licensure.

Failure to provide the above information and pay the required fees shall be grounds to deny the application for licensure.

HAR section 16-85-7(c) provides:

It shall be each applicant's responsibility to furnish any information and documentation requested by the board. In the event of any change of information provided, the applicant shall notify the board in writing within thirty days of any change.

It was moved by Dr. Young, seconded by Vice-Chair Halford, and unanimously carried to approve the following application:

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Holt, and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Saheli's application pending submission of the correct application, the Application for Licensure (MD License), non-endorsement.

It was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Vice-Chair Halford, and unanimously carried to ratify the attached list of individuals for licensure or certification.

Correspondence:

A. Email inquiry from Rebecca Stein, M.D., regarding American Medical Association ("AMA") no longer providing AMA Physician

Profiles for individuals who completed accredited graduate medical education training in Canada.

The Board members reviewed the email correspondence from Dr. Stein regarding the AMA no longer providing AMA Physician Profiles for individuals who completed accredited graduate medical education training in Canada. By way of background, the AMA previously provided Physician Profiles for physicians who successfully completed graduate medical education programs accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada ("RCPSC") or the College of Family Physicians of Canada ("CFPC").

Ms. Quiogue reminded Board members that HAR section 16-85-7(a)(6) requires physician (MD) applicants to submit a completed profile from the AMA.

Given the AMA's change in policy, Ms. Quiogue asked the Board members whether they would consider waiving the requirement to submit a completed AMA Physician Profile for physician (MD) applicants who have successfully completed a RCPSC or CFPC-accredited graduate medical education training program in Canada.

Chair Geimer-Flanders asked whether the Board will need to amend its administrative rules.

Ms. Quiogue answered in the affirmative, and stated that the Board must make a decision on this matter now because some applicants are unable to move forward with their application to obtain an MD license due to the recent change in policy by the AMA.

DAG Wong concurred with Ms. Quiogue, and stated that often times statutes and/or administrative rules may lag behind newer policies, etc. She went on to say that this matter will be included when the Board starts its next rule package.

Chair Geimer-Flanders is of the opinion that the Board should waive the requirement of the AMA Physician Profile for physicians (MD) applicants who successfully completed graduate medical education training accredited by the RCPSC or CFPC.

Ms. Quiogue further clarified that due to the change in the AMA's policy, the waiver of the AMA Physician Profile would only apply to Canadian medical graduates that completed one year of residency training in a RCPSC or CFPC-accredited program in Canada. All other physician (MD) applicants must still submit a completed AMA Physician Profile.

Dr. Dao asked whether the AMA specified the reason to its recent change in policy.

Ms. Quiogue stated that there were no details provided to the Board by AMA behind the recent change in policy. Furthermore, a Canadian medical graduate will not be able to obtain an Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (“ECFMG”) certification because they are not treated as international medical graduates.

Chair Geimer-Flanders stated that the Committee on Accreditation of Canadian Medical Schools (“CACMS”) works directly with the Liaison Committee on Medical Education in the United States to, among other things, ensure that Canadian medical schools meet specific requirements to become accredited. The U.S.A. views Canadian medical schools as being on par with U.S. medical schools provided that they are accredited by the CACMS. Given this information, there is not a mechanism for them to go through ECFMG certification process.

Ms. Quiogue clarified that U.S.A. has determined that only Canadian allopathic medical schools and residency programs are equivalent to programs accredited in the U.S.A.

Due to a change with the AMA policy for certain physicians, it was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Egami, and unanimously carried to no longer require a completed AMA Physician Profile for applicants who completed a RCPSC or CFPC-accredited Canadian graduate medical education training program.

Future Board Meetings:

The Board considered the frequency of board meetings and advisory committee meetings for the remainder of the year.

Chair Geimer-Flanders reminded Board members that, based on past delegations, the Board Chairperson was delegated the authority to review and approve applications. Based on that delegation, she and the Board’s Executive Officer have met virtually since its last meeting in March 2020, to review applications. Any applications that she believes go beyond her delegated authority would come to the Board for review.

Ms. Quiogue added that given the number of administrative staff needed to produce these virtual meetings, the division has also asked that boards/commissions/committees consider the number of meetings it holds. In addition to an executive officer and secretary, it takes 2-3 additional staff members to hold one virtual meeting.

It was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Vice-Chair Halford, and unanimously carried to revise the Board meeting schedule to every other month for the remainder of the year in 2020. A decision will be made on the meeting schedule for the 2021 calendar at the December meeting.
