Chair Geimer-Flanders welcomed its newest member, Mr. Gary Belcher to the Board. Mr. Belcher will serve in one of two public member positions on the Board.

Mr. Belcher offers an impressive amount of administrative medical experience through his years of affiliation with the University of Hawaii, John A. Burns School of Medicine. He served as the program administrator for the University of Hawaii Surgical Residency Program, Orthopaedic Residency Program, and Surgical Critical Care Fellowship. Additionally, Mr. Belcher has served twice as a public member on the Board of Speech Pathology and Audiology, including serving as the vice chairperson.

Legislation:

A. HB313, HD2 SD1 CD1 RELATING TO PHYSICIAN  
WORKFORCE ASSESSMENT

The Board discussed the above bill.

The purposes of this bill are to: repeal the requirement that no less than fifty per cent of the physician workforce assessment fees transferred or deposited into the John A. Burns School of Medicine ("JABSOM") special fund be expended for purposes identified by the Hawaii Medical Education Council to support physician workforce assessment and planning efforts; repeal the cap on expenditures from the JABSOM special fund; and authorize funds from the JABSOM special fund to be expended for loan repayments to physicians who commit to working in certain medically underserved areas as part of the Hawaii State Loan Repayment Program and scholarships to qualifying medical students.

Ms. Quiogue informed members that after the agenda was filed, this bill was signed into law as Act 151 (Gov. Msg. No. 153).

B. SB324, SD1 HD1 CD1 RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE

The Board discussed the above bill.

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the definition of the practice of medicine to provide uniformity of practice for both medical physicians and osteopathic physicians.

This bill was signed into law as Act 97 (Gov. Msg. No. 1199).

C. SB970, SD2 RELATING TO TELEHEALTH

The Board discussed the above bill.

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the establishment of a physician-patient relationship via a telehealth interaction if the physician is licensed to practice medicine in the State.

This bill was signed into law as Act 34 (Gov. Msg. No. 1134).

D. SB1340, SD2 HD2 CD1 RELATING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES

The Board discussed the above bill.

The purposes of this bill are to: authorize the Hawaii Medical Board to license emergency ambulance service personnel; create an additional licensure category for emergency medical technicians 1 who are certified at a higher practice level than emergency medical technicians, but do not provide ambulance services; and appropriate funds from the Compliance Resolution Fund for hiring a 0.5 full-time equivalent (0.5 FTE) permanent position. This bill is effective 7/1/2021.

This bill was signed into law as Act 119 (Gov. Msg. No. 1221).

Dr. Jaffe asked Ms. Quiogue if the above language meant the Board would be asked to oversee paramedics and allied health professionals in the emergency medical field.

Ms. Quiogue advised that the Board currently regulates the following allied health professions:

1. Emergency Medical Technicians (“EMT”)
2. Emergency Medical Technicians 1
3. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians
4. Paramedics
5. Podiatrists; and
6. Physician Assistants

Dr. Jaffe questioned if the Board should have a representative from one of the said allied fields to help with decision making.

Ms. Quiogue noted that currently the Board’s statutes establish advisory committees for physician assistants, emergency medical personnel, and podiatrists. She went on to explain that these committees are responsible for providing recommendations to the Board.

E. HR99, HD1 REQUESTING THE CONVENING OF A WORKING GROUP TO DETERMINE THE GAPS IN ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE AND THE POTENTIAL ROLE ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES MAY PLAY IN ADDRESSING THESE GAPS

The Board discussed the above House resolution.

The purpose of this measure is to convene a working group to determine the gaps in access to health care and the potential role advanced practice registered nurses may play in addressing these gaps.

Ms. Quiogue advised that the members that the resolution was adopted in final form.

F. HR100, HD1 REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CONDUCT AN ANALYSIS OF ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS.

The Board discussed the above House resolution.

The purpose of this measure is to request the Legislative Reference Bureau to conduct an analysis of advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants.

This resolution was adopted in final form.

Ms. Quiogue noted that these House resolutions are not concurrent resolutions, therefore, the Board is not obligated to proceed with action on these resolutions.

New Business: A. Disability and Communication Access Board to Issue new Disability Paid Parking Exemption Permit ("DPPEP").

The Disability and Communication Access Board (DCAB) has released an application form with an instruction sheet for the new Disability Paid Parking Exemption Permit (DPPEP).

Ms. Quiogue noted the above media release was for informational purposes. Ms. Quiogue also asked the members to disseminate the information amongst their colleague's and affiliated facilities/organizations.
