Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

A short video was played to explain the meeting procedures and how members of the public could participate in the virtual meeting.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 1:05 p.m., at which time quorum was established.

***Dr. Takanishi entered the Zoom meeting at 1:05 p.m.***

Chair Geimer-Flanders welcomed everyone to the meeting and proceeded with a roll call of the Board members. All Board members

confirmed that they were present and alone. Peter Holt, M.D., Honolulu Member, was excused from the meeting.

Approval of the  
April 14, 2022,  
Minutes:

It was moved by Dr. Takanishi, seconded by Dr. Dao, and carried by the majority, with the exception of Dr. Halford who abstained from the vote, to approve the meeting minutes of the executive session and the meeting minutes of the open session of the April 14, 2022, meeting, as circulated.

Adjudicatory  
Matters:

Chair Geimer-Flanders called for a recess from the meeting at 1:09 p.m., to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter pursuant to Chapter 91, HRS (Note: Board members and staff entered the Microsoft Teams meeting).

A. In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of Jeffrey D. Lovin, M.D., Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Takanishi, and unanimously carried to revoke Dr. Lovin's license based on his failure to comply with the Board's Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Actions and Board's Final Order dated December 13, 2018. To expedite this matter, the Board delegated to Ms. Quiogue, the authority to sign on its behalf a final order reflecting its decision.

B. In the Matter of the Physician's License of Dane S. Travis, M.D., Hearings Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order, Granting Summary Judgment in Favor of Petitioner; MED-2021-23-L<sup>1</sup>.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Takanishi, seconded by Dr. Halford, and unanimously carried, to approve the aforementioned Hearings Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order, Granting Summary Judgment in Favor of Petitioner; MED-2021-23-L.

C. In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of Sung S. Yang, M.D., Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petitioner for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved

by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Takanishi, and unanimously carried, to approve the aforementioned Settlement Agreement After Filing of Petitioner for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

Following the Board's review, deliberation, and decision on these matters pursuant to Chapter 91, HRS, Chair Geimer-Flanders announced that the Board reconvened to its regular Chapter 92, HRS, meeting at 1:22 p.m. Board members and staff returned to the Zoom meeting.

Chair Geimer-Flanders asked if anyone from the public would like to provide oral testimony on agenda item 3. Chapter 91, Adjudicatory Matters.

It was reported that two individuals raised their hands. Chair Geimer-Flanders reminded these individuals that the open session portion of the meeting is public record under the Sunshine law, and they could provide testimony in the executive session portion of the meeting if they were here to discuss a pending application. She went on to say that the executive session is not subject to public record.

*Dr. Barsoumian was promoted to a panelist at 1:25 pm.*

Dr. Barsoumian introduced himself and stated that he is present and available to answer questions.

*Dr. Barsoumian returned to an attendee at 1:26 p.m.*

*Mr. Eric Irwin was promoted to a panelist at 1:26 p.m.*

Mr. Eric Irwin, Regulated Industries Complaints Office ("RICO"), introduced himself and stated that he is present in regard to agenda item 3.a. In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of Jeffrey D. Lovin, M.D., Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order. He stated that he filed an affidavit of non-compliance, is seeking revocation of Dr. Lovin's license, and is available to answer questions.

Mr. Irwin was advised that the Board voted to revoke Mr. Lovin's medical license. A Board's Final Order For Noncompliance With A Previous Board's Final Order would be issued and its Executive Officer will sign on behalf of the Board.

a. James R. Schwartz, M.D.

It was moved by Dr. Fong, seconded by Dr. Takanishi, and carried by a majority, with the exception of Dr. Young who recused herself from the discussion and vote on this matter, to return to the open session meeting at 3:12 p.m. Board members and staff returned to the Zoom meeting.

*Dr. Young rejoined the Zoom meeting at 3:13 p.m.*

(i) Physician (Permanent/Endorsement):

a. Raffi Barsoumian, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Takanishi, seconded by Dr. Young, and unanimously carried to approve Dr. Barsoumian's application, pending the submission of three license verifications.

(ii) Physician (Permanent/Non-Endorsement)

a. James R. Schwartz, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Halford, seconded by Dr. Egami, and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Schwartz's application.

The Board based its decision on the following grounds of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which find factual support in the records and files of Dr. Schwartz's application:

HRS §453-8 provides that:

(a) In addition to any other actions authorized by law, any license to practice medicine and surgery may be revoked, limited, or suspended by the board at any time in a proceeding before the board, or may be denied, for any cause authorized by law, including but not limited to the following:

\* \* \*

(7) Professional misconduct, hazardous negligence causing bodily injury to another, or manifest incapacity in the practice of medicine or surgery;

(8) Incompetence or multiple instances of negligence, including but not limited to the consistent use of medical service, which is inappropriate or unnecessary; and

- (11) Revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another state or federal agency of a license, certificate, or medical privilege.

The Board considers Dr. Schwartz's conduct to be extremely concerning and contrary to the recognized standards of ethics as adopted by the American Medical Associations ("AMA"). Specifically, Dr. Schwartz failed to uphold the following AMA Principle of Medical Ethics:

- II. A physician shall uphold the standards of professionalism, be honest in all professional interactions, and strive to report physicians deficient in character or competence, or engaging in fraud or deception, to appropriate entities.

(iii) Emergency Medical Personnel:

a. Kelly Scott Halpin, EMT

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Jaffe, seconded by Dr. Takanishi, and carried by a majority, with the exception of Dr. Young who recused herself from the discussion and vote on this matter, to approve Mr. Halpin's application.

D. Ratifications List (See attached list)

(i) List

It was moved by Chair Geimer-Flanders, seconded by Dr. Takanishi, and unanimously carried to ratify the attached list of individuals for licensure or certification.

Legislation:

Chair Geimer-Flanders asked if any members of the public wish to provide oral testimony at this time. There were none.

A. HB1575, HD2, SD2, RELATING TO PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS

The purposes of this bill are to: expand the scope of practice for physician assistants; and require a sampling of medical records that includes certain amounts of controlled substance prescriptions, rather than all medical records, to be reviewed when physician assistants prescribe controlled substances.

If enacted, this measure would become effective on July 1, 2022.

Ms. Quiogue reported that as of May 4, 2022, this bill was transmitted to the Governor for consideration and enactment.

B. HB1823, HD2, SD2, RELATING TO HEALTH

The purposes of this bill are to: authorize advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants to practice medical aid in dying or provide counseling to a qualified patient; require an attending provider to make an initial determination in person or via telehealth; amend the mandatory waiting period between oral requests and the provision of a prescription; and prohibit the disclosure, discovery, or compelled production of information collected or retained pursuant to incidental or routine communication between DOH and qualified patients or providers. This bill would become effective on July 1, 2060 if enacted.

Ms. Quiogue reported that as of April 28, 2022, the House and Senate committees could not agree on a conference draft. Therefore, the bill is dead and will not move forward.

C. SB2017, SD1, HD2, CD1, RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

The purpose of this bill is to repeal existing law that limits licensure as an emergency medical technician 1 to individuals whose practice is performed in a county with a population of 500,000 or greater.

Ms. Quiogue reported that as of May 6, 2022, the bill was enrolled to Governor for his consideration.
