Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 11:08 p.m., at which time quorum was established.

Chair Takanishi welcomed everyone to the meeting and proceeded with a roll call of the Board members. All Board members confirmed that they were present and alone. Franklin V.H. Dao, M.D., Honolulu Member, was excused from the meeting.

August 11, 2022,  
Minutes:

It was moved by Dr. Egami, seconded by Dr. Jaffe, and carried by a majority, with the exception of Dr. Fong who abstained from the vote, to approve the meeting minutes of the executive session and the meeting minutes of the open session of the August 11, 2022, meeting, as circulated.

A roll call vote was taken and Chair Takanishi, Mr. Belcher, Dr. Egami, Dr. Jaffe, Mr. Mun, Dr. Sawai, and Dr. Young voted to approve the minutes.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Egami, seconded by Dr. Jaffe, and unanimously carried, to approve the aforementioned Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

B. In the Matter of the License to Practice Medicine of John M. Kurap, M.D.; MED 2022-16-L; Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Mr. Belcher, seconded by Dr. Jaffe and unanimously carried, to approve the aforementioned Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action and Board's Final Order.

(i) Physician (Permanent/Endorsement):

a. Samir Hadi, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Sawai, seconded by Mr. Belcher, and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Hadi's application pending a comprehensive clinical competency assessment completed by one of the following Post-licensure Assessment System ("PLAS") programs:

- CPEP (The Center for Personalized Education for Professionals)
- Drexel Medicine Physician Refresher / Re-entry Course
- Florida Competency Advancement Program
- KSTAR (Knowledge Skills Training Assessment and Research)
- LifeGuard
- Physician Assessment and Clinical Education (PACE)

The Board cites the following statutory provision, which authorizes it to require Dr. Hadi to undergo a comprehensive clinical competency assessment:

HRS §436B-10(a)(9):

(a) Application for a license shall be made on an application form to be furnished by the licensing authority. An applicant shall provide the following information on the application form:

(9) Any other information the licensing authority may require to investigate the applicant's qualifications for licensure.

Failure to provide the above information and pay the required fees shall be grounds for denial.

(ii) Physician (Permanent/Non-Endorsement):

a. Salvador G. Borrromeo, III, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Fong, seconded by Dr. Egami, and unanimously carried to deny Dr. Borrromeo's application.

The Board based its decision on the following grounds of the HRS and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR"), which find factual support in the records and files of Dr.

Borromeo's application:

HRS §453-8 provides that:

- (a) In addition to any other actions authorized by law, any license to practice medicine and surgery may be revoked, limited, or suspended by the board at any time in a proceeding before the board, or may be denied, for any cause authorized by law, including but not limited to the following:
  - (6) Procuring a license through fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or knowingly permitting an unlicensed person to perform activities requiring a license;
  - (9) Conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession as adopted by the Hawaii Medical Association, the American Medical Association, the Hawaii Association of Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons, or the American Osteopathic Association;
  - (11) Revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another state or federal agency of a license, certificate, or medical privilege; and
  - (15) Submitting to or filing with the board any notice, statement, or other document required under this chapter, which is false or untrue or contains any material misstatement or omission of fact.

HAR §16-85-107(a)(3) provides that:

- (a) An application for issuance of a license or certificate shall be denied when an application is insufficient or incomplete or when an applicant has failed to provide satisfactory proof that the applicant meets the requirements under chapters 453 or 463E, HRS, or this chapter. In addition, the board may deny issuance of a license or certificate:
  - (3) If the applicant has had disciplinary action taken by any jurisdiction, including any federal or state regulatory body.

The Board considers Dr. Borromeo's conduct extremely

concerning and contrary to the recognized standards of ethics as adopted by the American Medical Association (“AMA”). Specifically, the Board believes that Dr. Borromeo failed to uphold the following AMA Principle of Medical Ethics:

II. A physician shall uphold the standards of professionalism, be honest in all professional interactions, and strive to report physicians deficient in character or competence, or engaging in fraud or deception, to appropriate entities.

b. John H. Hotchkiss, M.D.

Dr. Hotchkiss requested that his application be deferred to another meeting until he is able to attend. After consideration of this request, it was moved by Dr. Egami, seconded by Mr. Belcher, and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Hotchkiss’s application.

c. Igor Mitreski, M.D.:

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Jaffe, seconded by Dr. Egami, and unanimously carried to defer Dr. Mitreski’s application pending a comprehensive clinical competency assessment completed by one of the following PLAS programs:

- CPEP (The Center for Personalized Education for Professionals)
- Drexel Medicine Physician Refresher / Re-entry Course
- Florida Competency Advancement Program
- KSTAR (Knowledge Skills Training Assessment and Research)
- LifeGuard
- Physician Assessment and Clinical Education (PACE)

The Board cites the following statutory provision, which authorizes it to require Dr. Mitreski to undergo a comprehensive clinical competency assessment:

HRS §436B-10(a)(9):

(a) Application for a license shall be made on an application form to be furnished by the licensing authority. An applicant shall provide the following information on the application form:

- (9) Any other information the licensing authority may require to investigate the applicant's qualifications for licensure.

Failure to provide the above information and pay the required fees shall be grounds for denial.

Further, as a requirement to proceed with the application process, the Board requires that Dr. Mitreski pay the outstanding balance of the administrative fine owed to the Regulated Industries Complaints Office pursuant to the Board's Final Order dated December 11, 2014, in Case No. MED-2014-35-L. Based on the Board's records, Dr. Mitreski owes \$4,500.00.

d. Dustan Osborn, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Fong, seconded by Dr. Egami, and unanimously carried, to instruct Dr. Osborn to submit a revised application and issue a non-disciplinary letter of education.

e. Krupa Pathak, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Mr. Belcher, seconded by Dr. Egami, and carried by a majority, with the exception of Chair Takanishi, who abstained from voting on this matter, to approve Dr. Pathak's request for sponsorship to retake USMLE Step 3.

A roll call vote was taken and Mr. Belcher, Dr. Egami, Dr. Fong, Dr. Jaffe, Mr. Mun, Dr. Sawai, and Dr. Young voted in favor of approving Dr. Pathak's request.

f. Garrett K. Peel, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Dr. Sawai, seconded by Mr. Belcher, and carried by a majority, with the exception of Dr. Jaffe who abstained from voting, to deny Dr. Peel's application.

A roll call vote was taken and Chair Takanishi, Mr. Belcher, Dr. Egami, Dr. Fong, Mr. Mun, Dr. Sawai, and Dr. Young voted to deny this application.

The Board based its decision on the following grounds of the HRS and HAR, which find factual support in the records and files of Dr. Peel's application:

HRS §453-8 provides that:

- (a) In addition to any other actions authorized by law, any license to practice medicine and surgery may be revoked, limited, or suspended by the board at any time in a proceeding before the board, or may be denied, for any cause authorized by law, including but not limited to the following:
  - (6) Procuring a license through fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or knowingly permitting an unlicensed person to perform activities requiring a license;

g. Charles Ruzkowski, M.D.

After due consideration of the information received, it was moved by Mr. Belcher seconded by Dr. Jaffe and carried by a majority, with the exception of Dr. Young who recused herself from voting on this matter, to approve Dr. Ruzkowski's application.

A roll call vote was taken and Chair Takanishi, Mr. Belcher, Dr. Egami, Dr. Fong, Dr. Jaffe, Mr. Mun, and Dr. Sawai voted to approve this application.
